2019 ENROLMENT INFORMATION

Thank you for the interest you have shown in applying for a place at Rosebank Primary School. Completing an application form does not necessarily mean that the learner has been accepted at School.

Please note that applicants enrolling for Grade 0 must turn 5 years of age by the **30th June 2019** and **Grade 1 applicants must turn 6 before the 30th June 2019**.

Enrolment for Grade 1 must be done online through the Department of Education. The website to apply on is www.gdeadmissions.gov.za. Opening date for Enrolments of Grade 1 online applications is 16th April 2018 and CLOSES 28th May 2018. Applications for Grade R and Grade 2 to 7 open 16th April and CLOSES 28th May 2018 and must be submitted at the Front Office.

The language of learning and teaching at Rosebank Primary is ENGLISH, therefore it is imperative that your child be able to speak and understand it. A child that cannot speak English will not be admitted to the School.

Please be aware that the First additional language (FAL) from Grade R to Grade 3 is Afrikaans and Zulu. Grade 4 – 7 have a choice between Afrikaans and Zulu – this must please be indicated on the application.

DOCUMENTATION

The following documentation must be submitted with the completed application form.

1. Copy of unabridged birth certificate of the child. (shows both biological mother and father details)
2. Copy of official immunisation card, or proof confirming immunisation history only, not growth chart.
3. Latest school report. (Includes report from nursery school if applying for Grade 1)
4. Copy of parents' or guardians' identity documents.
5. The Court Order in the case of legally appointed guardian / foster parent.
6. Proof of residency – If a **home owner**, then your most recent **municipal (Water & Lights) account**; If a **tenant**, a certified copy of your **lease agreement**, accounts in you name **posted** to this address, as well as the **Landlords' water and lights account**. Or work address should you work in the zoned area.
7. Proof of income. (Recent Payslip) If self-employed a recent bank statement will be required.
8. Transfer Card. (This is only required to be handed in once received from the exiting school)

Immigrants and Refugees

A valid work permit as well as study permit for the pupil must be submitted. The permit must be valid at least until mid-2019.

In order to ensure that your application has every chance of consideration, it is vital that you read through this form carefully, provide all of the information and certificates required, and return the application form as quickly as possible. If false information has been provided, the child will not be admitted to the school. If the child is admitted to the school under false pretences, the child will be asked to leave the school. **If the required information is incorrect, incomplete, or documentation is missing, it will delay the processing and evaluation of the application.**

ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS – On acceptance of your child at Rosebank Primary School, you will be required to:

- **Pay a learner activity fee** which includes;
 - Grade 0 (exercise books, chair bag, apron, book bag, tog bag, 2 x T-shirts, photographs, Excursions, ear & eye test, plastic covers, photocopy paper, perceptual books)
 - Grade 1 – 7 (exercise books, plastic covers, perceptual books, photographs, ear & eye test, Photocopy paper, FAMSA grade 5 – 7)

The learner activity fee is compulsory on acceptance. If this is not paid, your child will not be accepted at the school. The amount will be communicated on acceptance.

- **2019 School Fees are estimated to be ± R16 000 for the year.** (confirmation at AGM in October 2018). The current school fees are R15 400 per annum.
- **Rosebank Primary School is a state-aided Section 21 school and the payment of school fees is compulsory.**

Please note that only original applications will be received, therefore no emailed applications will be accepted unless relocating from another province.

PLEASE NOTE that preference will be given to families who work or live in the zoned area. (5km radius of the school)
